- Come prepared! This adventure happens outdoors, and we all know what British weather is like
- Wear comfortable shoes. The walk is about 60 – 90 minutes if you start from Trinity Centre / 40min if you start from Newfoundland road

On your way to start the adventure

- You can either start from the Trinity Centre (A) or Newfoundland road (B), close to St Paul's Learning Centre. Refer to the map on p.7 of the Duppy Hunter Manual and head to your preferred starting point
- Follow the instructions on page 3 of the Duppy Hunter Manual to get started

Technical aspects to consider

- Once you start your adventure you can lock your screen, put your phone in your pocket and enjoy the experience. You will be prompted by a character and/or in moments of silence you will need to go back to your screen to either push a button, type in some text or even answer a question
- If you feel like you might be lost, you can also return to your screen and click the map icon, to get back on track
- The experience is web- based therefore the best browsers the programme supports are listed below:

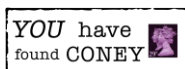
It is recommended that you check if your phone supports any one of the browsers listed before starting the adventure.
